

- What:** Dual credit opportunities allow you to enrich your studies by taking a college course delivered by highly trained college staff, while attending one of our Alternate Education and Training Centres (AETC).
- Who:** If you are 17-19 years of age, consider applying for a dual credit. Ages 19 and older are also welcome to apply, but preference is given to 17-19 year olds. (Limited spots available).
- Why:** Upon successful completion, participants will earn both a college credit and a secondary school credit. It is an excellent way to sample college, while working towards your secondary school diploma.
- Where:** Each of our Alternate Education and Training Centres (AETC) offers Dual credit opportunities.
- When:** Dual credits are offered at different times throughout the school year.
- Fee:** Student activity fee, per school year, is \$25, which includes all programs within our Alternate Education and Training Centres.
