

What: PLAR Credits (Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition) may be awarded to students who are registered at one of our Alternate Education and Training Centres (AETC).

Who: Students who entered grade 9 September, 1999, or later, may qualify for PLAR credits if they have fewer than 16 grade 9 and 10 credits.

Students with significant experience may also qualify for senior level equivalency credits.

Students must be over the age of 18 and have been out of school for 10 consecutive months.

Where: Every AETC. Students must attend in class to complete PLAR materials. Independent learning with a teacher in the room to assist you, as needed.

When: All year long, continuous intake, Monday to Friday.

How: An administrator at an AETC will meet with you to determine if you qualify for PLAR credits. You can also visit us at anewstart.ca
