

What: The Personal Support Worker (PSW) course is a certified and accredited program offered by the Community Training and Development Program, in partnership with T.L.D.S.B., at the Lindsay Alternate Education and Training Centre each fall. Successful completion of this full time program can count for up to five secondary school credits.

Who: 19 years of age and older.

Why: Graduates experience excellent job prospects and are often employed immediately.
